101 Outdoor Arts Creation Space is a dedicated rehearsal, fabrication and development centre for the outdoor arts sector in the UK.

Boasting 20,000sq ft. and encompassing warehouse rehearsal rooms, meeting spaces, a workshop, dining room, 2 kitchens and en-suite accommodation cabins for 15 people

101 provides a unique and creative place to make, shape and develop work for the outdoors and in public spaces. We host over 50 residencies every year from artists across the globe working in a wide range of artistic mediums, formats and scales. Alongside our residencies we also run the Out- door Arts Programme as part of the Corn Exchange, Newbury presenting wide reaching outdoor arts and transforming our local market town.





We are committed to providing support for artists working across the sector and have been developing a programme of ongoing professional development in the form of our 101Labs

Through seminars, talks, masterclasses, digital courses and workshops in partnership with experienced and inspirational people this programme aims to enable participants at any stage of their career to reflect on their own practice and to share and learn from one another.

Induction

At a convenient point after your arrival we will take you through the ins and outs of staying at 101 and show you around the facilities. If you would like any of this information in advance, please let us know.

Accommodation

You will be sleeping in a comfortable individual en-suite cabin at 101 (unless you have agreed to stay in a twin room) Each room contains: a bed (+ duvet, sheets and pillow), wardrobe, heater, lamp, shower, toilet and basin. We ask you to bring towels and toiletries, but bedding/bed linen is provided.

Other facilities

We have a laundry room with washing machines and tumble dryer and a Mezzanine space above the dining room which can be used for meetings or relaxing on the sofas in the evenings. We also have 2 new rooms under the new mezzanine in the Big Space which can be used as an office, green room or studio throughout your stay

Catering / Hospitality

Tea and coffee is provided for you in our communal kitchen along with any pans and plates you might need to prepare food yourself. Our communal kitchen and dining room areas are available to you throughout your stay so please feel free to use the allocated fridges to store anything you might need whilst you are here, access to the main building is available to you 24 hours.

There is a large Tesco Extra a 5-minute drive from 101. On the business park there is a café two buildings down from 101 inside The Base arts centre. See www.thebasegreenham.co.uk for opening times.

101 is located in Greenham Business Park just outside Newbury in West Berkshire. If you come into the business park via the main security entrance you will see a large black building called The Base on your left-hand side at the first roundabout. Continue past The Base and you will find us at the top of the road on the left-hand side.

There is some parking directly outside 101's building and along our chain link fence and alternative car parking around the business park if needed. When you arrive come to the front of the building and we will direct you to the best place.

Train



101 is a 50 minute walk from Newbury Station and trains run regularly between London, Reading & Basingstoke
